



Tournament Rules and Guidelines

VHSL rules except for modifications announced by the Colonial Athletic Association Youth Basketball Tournament will be used in this tournament.

The team listed first or on the top of the bracket will be the home team and will wear light-colored uniforms. The team listed second or on the bottom of the bracket will be the visiting team and will wear dark-colored uniforms.

Location:	Greater Richmond Convention Center
Participants:	10U-13U boys and girls
Games:	4 game guarantee
Game Balls:	10U-12U will play with a 28.5" ball 13U will play with a regulation ball Competition balls will be provided. Practice balls will not be provided.

Game Rules and Regulations

- 10U & 11U will play 14-minute halves, regulation clock
- 12U & 13U will play 16-minute halves, regulation clock
- Warm-up of 10 minutes, time permitting; no less than 5 minutes for warm-up
- Halftime: 5 minutes
- Overtime: 3 minutes
 - If a tie remains after the first overtime, an additional one-minute period will begin. All overtime periods begin with a jump ball.
- Each team will have 4 full time outs per game. They do not carry into overtime. Teams will have 1 time out during each overtime period.
- Players may enter the paint on the release of the ball.
- No full court press if a team is ahead by 20 or more points.
- If a team is ahead by 30 or more points, the game clock will continuously run.

Tournament Rules and Regulations

- Abusive coaches, spectators, or players may be removed from the game and/or building by game officials or facility supervisors. A coach will not be allowed to participate in the remainder of the tournament after a second technical
- Practice balls will not be provided.
- **Brackets posted at the tournament site are the official brackets.** Check for updates and changes that do not appear in the program or on the website.
- The home team (listed first on the bracket) will be the official scorebook and provide official scorekeeper.



- Game time is **forfeit time!**
- Decisions by referees are final.
- Pool Play Tie breaker criteria: (1) head to head (2) point spread with a maximum of 15 points per game (3) points allowed (4) a coin flip
- A player can only play on one team.
- No roster changes/additions are permitted after 72 hours prior to the start of the tournament without tournament director approval. Absolutely no changes after a team's first game.
- Player ejection from the game by an official will result in the player sitting out the following game.
- If a team forfeits two or more pool games: the team will be disqualified from the event and cannot participate in the rest of the tournament.

Player Eligibility Requirements

Age group requirements:

Boys

13 and Under/7th grade - born on or after - September 1, 1995

Grade Exception: A player who is in the 7th grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1994 can participate in the 13: under/7th grade division. Maximum of three grade exception athletes per team.

12 and Under/6th grade - born on or after - September 1, 1996

Grade Exception: A player who is in the 6th grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1995 can participate in the 12: under/6th grade division. Maximum of three grade exception athletes per team.

11 and Under/5th grade - born on or after - September 1, 1997

Grade Exception: A player who is in the 5th grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1996 can participate in the 11: under/5th grade division. Maximum of three grade exception athletes per team.

10 and Under/4th grade - born on or after - September 1, 1998

Grade Exception: A player who is in the 4th grade and who was born on or after September 1, 1997 can participate in the 10: under/4th grade division. Maximum of three grade exception athletes per team.

Girls

10 & Under/5th grade: Born in 1998 or after or in the 5th Grade & born in 1997 or after

11 & Under/6th grade Born in 1997 or after or in the 6th Grade & born in 1996 or after

12 & Under/7th grade Born in 1996 or after or in the 7th Grade & born in 1995 or after

13 & Under/8th grade Born in 1995 or after or in the 8th Grade & born in 1994 or after
