## Activity: Protect The Pin

Equipment  • Hoops	Set Up  • Divide the playing area into 2 halves
<ul> <li>Bowling Pins (or large cones)</li> </ul>	<ul><li>with a center line of cones</li><li>Choose a number of targets for each team and layout that number of</li></ul>
• Soft balls	<ul> <li>hoops in each teams court</li> <li>Put a bowling pin in each hoop</li> <li>Place a number of soft balls on the</li> </ul>
	center line

## How To Play:

- Divide the group into two teams. Each team must start touching the back line/wall
- On "Go" students run in and collect the balls and can start throwing at the other teams pins
- If a pin is knocked over by a ball or a student, it is out of the game
- Students may protect their teams pins by blocking the balls with any parts of their bodies or catching them
- Students are NOT out if the get hit with the ball
- Penalty time (20-30secs) are awarded if: A player crosses the center line, a player steps into the hoop to protect the pin, or if a player holds more than 1 ball
- The first team to knock all of the other team's pins down wins.
